

Workplace Supervision and Fall Protection Safety

1. Overview

Participants who complete this programme will enhance their ability to supervise teams, reduce workplace incidents at height, and comply with legislative requirements. This qualification is particularly valuable for those seeking supervisory positions or involved in tasks requiring work at height.
